DAY01 FEBRUARY 22 MANILA ROME

Check in at the airport, aboard your favorite airline. Enjoy in flight amenities, meals and entertainment.

DAY02 FEBRUARY 23 ARRIVE ROME (D)

Upon arrival in Rome, you will have a short orientation of sights and landmarks in the city. Rome is the largest and the capital of Italy, it's the country's most populated commune and the fourth-most populous city in the European Union by population within city limits. Some free time before dinner. Transfer to hotel for check in.

DAY03 FEBRUARY 24 ROME (BD)

After breakfast, you will visithe Vatican Museum and Sistine Chapel, one of the most visited places in the Vatican City, this was established on 1929 by the Lateran Treaty. Then, we'll spend some time at St. Peter's Basilica and its Square. The rest of day is free for shopping in Spanish Steps. Dinner and back to the hotel.

DAY04 FEBRUARY 25 ROME - FLORENCE (BD)

Morning drive to Venetto passing Umbria and Tuscany Regions. Today, you'll be transferred to Florence-one of the liveliest and most creative in Europe with some of the world's greatest Works of Art and magnificent buildings. Upon arrival you will proceed to the city for sightseeing tour. Visit includes the works of Michelangelo, the Cathedral and its dome, the Baptistery, then to the open gallery of Piazza Signoria. Dinner and check in at the hotel.

DAY05 FEBRUARY 26 FLORENCE – VENICE (BD)

On this day, you will see the magical city of Venice, also known as the city of Marco Polo, then continue to Troncheto pier and take a ride to San Marco. DAY06 FEBRUARY 27 VENICE - INNSBRUCK (BD)

After a hearty breakfast, you will proceed to Innsbruck. You will spend your day in this beautiful old town. Innsbruck is the provincial capital of Tyrol and the fifth largest city in Austria by population. Dinner and check in.

DAY07 FEBRUARY 28 INNSBRUCK -SCHAFHAUSSEN- LUCERNE (BD)

After breakfast, visit Swarovksky Factory before leaving Austria for Lucerne via Schafhausen, see the largest plain waterfall in Europe. Then enjoy the breath-taking sights going to Lucerne. Check in upon arrival.

DAY08 MARCH 01 LUCERNE- MT.TITLIS-LUCERNE (BD)

After breakfast, your tour will be highlighted by taking to the Peak of Mt. Titlis (10,000 feet) by revolving car, take time to enjoy the panoramic view of the Swiss Alps as you spend your time taking pictures of the snowcapped mountains. Later, go back to Lucerne for shopping. Do not forget to visit the Wooden Bridge and appreciate the view of the Lake Lucerne. Dinner will be at the hotel.

DAY09 MARCH 02 LUCERNE- PARIS (BD)

Say goodbye to magnificent city of Lucerne as we drive to Paris. It will take almost 7 hours to reach Paris. Check in and dinner upon arrival in the City of Lights!

DAY10 MARCH 03 PARIS (BD)

Paris is the world's most popular city destination and has plenty of must-see places where you will witness today. Your English speaking guide will start the comprehensive tour with an outside view of Notre Dame Cathedral. See the façade of Louvre Museum, Champs Elysees, Arch of Triomphe, The Opera, Concorde Square, Vendom Square and to top it all ascend to the second level of Eiffel Tower (or see Monalisa at Louvre Museum).
